Present these words to your child in a random order. For example, do not go through the “aid” words all in a row.

A line above a vowel (for example, ā) indicates that it is the “long” vowel sound, which is the same as the vowel’s name.

īz (eyes)	buys, dies, lies, pies, size, ties, wise
ōk (oak)	joke, poke, soak, coke, yoke, choke
ōn (own)	bone, cone, phone, loan, moan, tone, zone
ōt (oat)	boat, coat, goat, moat, note, quote, tote, vote
ōz (owes)	bows, goes, nose, rose, toes, chose, shows
ūz (use)	fuse, muse, views, pews
