WORD LIST

The words below are organized by the number of sounds (phonemes) they contain, but you should present them to the child in a random order so he/she gets a good mix in each session.

A line above a vowel (for example, \bar{a}) indicates that it is the “long” vowel sound, which is the same as the vowel’s name.

Remember, the number of sounds in a word is not necessarily the same as the number of letters!
