SIGHTWORDS.com Corrections Procedure

When a child makes a mistake reading a sight word, you need to correct them <u>on the spot</u>. If you wait until later, the correction is less likely to "stick" in the child's memory. Print out this script and be sure to have it with you <u>every time</u> you do a sight words lesson or game.

ADULT: That word is <u>should</u>. What word?

CHILD: Should.

ADULT: Again. What word?

CHILD: Should.

ADULT: Yes, should!

We should brush our teeth before

bed.

What word?

CHILD: Should.

After the correction, simply continue with the activity.
